NNL's founder Rube Foster's mantra of "We are the Ship . . . All Else the Sea" spoke to their exclusion from Major League Baseball. Their struggles became our successes as Black Baseball exploded in popularity and became an integral part of baseball Americana. Since 1998, in partnership with the Society for American Baseball Research (SABR), the Malloy Conference has been the only symposium dedicated exclusively to the examination and promotion of Blackball history. The conference is open to baseball and history fans of all ages. Each year, monies are targeted to donate books to schools or libraries; raise funds for the Jeremy Krock's Grave Marker Project; and award college grants to high school seniors in a national essay contest, along with a nationwide art contest. An added bonus is the presence of Negro League veterans at the conference.
