Jerry Malloy Scholarships Frequently Asked Questions

Question: Can I apply for more than one of the scholarships?

<u>Answer</u>: Yes, you can apply for all four scholarships. Each requires a separate application and essay. A student can only be awarded one scholarship.

Question: Can my guidance counselor email the letter of recommendation separately?

<u>Answer:</u> Yes, the letter of recommendation can be emailed separately from the application. It can be emailed to <u>lheaphy@kent.edu</u>. Please ask that they put the student name in the subject line.

Question: Are only African American students able to apply for these scholarships?

<u>Answer:</u> No, any high school senior planning to attend college or university in the fall is eligible to apply.

Question: Do you have to be going to a certain college to apply?

Answer: As long as you are attending an accredited US school you can apply.

Question: Do I have to mail the application as well as email the application?

<u>Answer:</u> No, you only need to submit your application one way—email is preferred. <u>lheaphy@kent.edu</u>.

Question: Do I have to provide citations for my essay?

<u>Answer:</u> yes, you need to provide citations for all your quotations and material that is not your own—failure to cite material will disqualify your essay. You can provide in whatever format you have learned in school. Regardless of format citations must be provided.

<u>Question:</u> For the essay when it says 1200 words is that a maximum or a minimum? Answer: The essays should be in the range of 1200 words (800-1500). Question: How will winners be notified?

<u>Answer:</u> Winners will be called and emailed when the decisions are reached. Announcements will also be placed on the Web and on social media by SABR.
