In addition to founding this groundbreaking black-owned and -operated business, Foster also founded and managed the Chicago American Giants, one of the most successful Black

Baseball teams of the pre-integration era. This definitive biography combines period editorials and correspondence with insightful narrative to provide a comprehensive portrait of this innovative Hall of Famer. From the unstructured early days of Black Baseball, when Foster gained glory as a hard-throwing pitcher, through his struggles to establish the NNL and his American Giants, to his tragic death from complications of syphilis, this work pays overdue tribute to an authentic American baseball icon.
